### **Eye Safety During a Solar Eclipse**

Except during the brief total phase of a total solar eclipse, when the Moon completely blocks the Sun's bright face, it is not safe to look directly at the Sun without specialized eye protection for solar viewing.

Viewing any part of the bright Sun through a camera lens, binoculars, or a telescope without a special-purpose solar filter secured over the front of the optics will instantly cause severe eye injury.

ARAW will have a limited amount of Eclipse Glasses that comply with ISO 12312-2 certified international standard (which is what NASA recommends)


