





> Tip: Verify the story with family before sending money.

Scammers pretend to be from the IRS, Social Security, or even your bank. They'll demand money or threaten legal action.

Tip: Legitimate agencies won't call you to demand payment or threaten you.

#### **Educational Programs:**

- · Learn the essentials of estate planning.

#### **Document Drafting:**

- By Appointment Only! Registration limited
- Income-eligible older adults can receive personalized legal assistance to draft and execute crucial documents, including: simple will, durable power of attorney, and health care proxy.

#### How to Participate:

- Financial eligibility: participants must be screened for income eligibility to qualify for the free drafting services.
- Appointment Required: mini consultations are by appointment only.
- Preparation is key: completed forms and a 10-minute consultation with an attorney are required before document drafting.
- Leave the clinic with completed and legally binding documents, along with a clear understanding of their purpose.
- We handle all the details, including providing witnesses for signing!
